- The meeting was called to order by Pam Mullins, Vice President

Mecca Baxter has offered to volunteer this year and will be donating beauty control products. It was also suggested that the left over cups be used. Pam stated she needed someone to do games and do prizes. Mecca will do Wheel of Fortune, and use upstairs stuff for prizes. Pam also stated that we would not be doing Popeyes or Cotton Candy due to wanting to keep it simple by being easy to clean up. Pam also stated that it cost more to have electricity due to this, and we were going to try and eliminate using electricity. The popcorn can be pre-bagged and sell by the bag. - Mr. Hogard has batteries and flashlights and would like to sell remainder at cost.

Forms for written permission from parents will be put together in order to get written permission from parents to post pictures of their children on the website. Mr. Hogard volunteered to get the forms in order for the beginning of the new school year.
